THE WORK:

The Consultant will provide the staff and resources necessary to perform professional environmental services, that include monitoring and inspections as required for the ARWL Project (Project) and in compliance with the California Department of Industrial Relations prevailing wage requirements. The Project is a major component of TCWD's existing raw water transmission line that supplies up to 5 million gallons per day of untreated raw water to TCWD's Dimension Water Treatment Plant in the City of Lake Forest. The Project consists of the construction of approximately 4,560 feet of 16-inch pipeline, the demolition of select portions of the existing pipeline, and connection to the existing pipeline. The Project is funded by grant programs from FEMA and Cal OES and as such must follow the grant program requirements for construction and administration.
