- Discussion of TCWD health benefit costs (F/A) Mr. Paludi reported that staff will provide an analysis of the CalPERS approved CY 2024 health rates and expected budgetary impacts.
- California Voting Rights Act (CVRA) Mr. Paludi reported that District General Counsel recommends a discussion with the Board of Directors on the potential impacts of the CVRA on the District, and he mentioned that the City of Rancho Santa Margarita (RSM) is currently evaluating the implementation of divisional seats. OTHER MATTERS

ITEM 3: REPORTS OR COMMENTS FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER AND/OR STAFF

Mr. Paludi provided a brief update on the following matters:

• Public Education Event Planning

Mr. Paludi provided an update on the planning for the Facilities Tour event scheduled for October 2023, and discussion occurred concerning the development of the tour itinerary. Director Dopudja recommended the event focus the day in the life of water in the District's service area and how the rates and charges fund critical infrastructure.

• Customer Meter Downsizing Requests – Policy & Process

Mr. Paludi reported that the District has received requests from some customers to downsize their meters due in response to the recently adopted rates and charges. Discussion occurred concerning the development of a District program to address customer concerns. Mr. Perea provided an overview of the impacted customers and related fiscal impacts to the District. The Committee requested the total number of residential metered connections sized from 1" to 2", and recommended agendizing this matter for discussion at the next committee meeting and a future regular board meeting.

• Dove Canyon V-Ditch/Slope Repair

Mr. Paludi provided a brief update on the Dove Canyon Master Association (DCMA) V-Ditch/Slope Repair project and the impacts to the District's properties and facilities adjacent to the project area. Mr. Paludi reported that DCMA's General Manager has requested the District's position concerning responsibility to participate/contribute to the project. Discussion occurred concerning the project's impacts, costs, and timeline for completion.

• Dove Plaza Reciprocal Parking Agreement – Final Draft

Mr. Paludi provided a brief update on this matter, and he reported that property management for the plaza has requested information concerning the frequency of after-hours events that may impact on their parking area. Discussion occurred concerning the number of District-related and community events that may occur at the District's Administration Facility throughout the year and have the potential to create overflow parking. Mr. Paludi commented that District staff will relay this information to the property management concerning this matter.
