# TCWD SECURES NEARLY \$1 MILLION IN GRANTS FOR INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES

TCWD is delivering on our commitment to pursue grant funding to defray the cost of capital improvement projects and help manage water and sewer rates for our customers. In April, the District was awarded \$578,000 from the federal government for construction of the Dove and Tick Creek Pump Station Improvements Drought Resiliency Project. The financial assistance will reimburse the District for half of the project's cost. When combined with a \$378,000 grant that TCWD received from the State of California last year, the project's \$1 million total cost will be almost entirely paid for through non-ratepayer funding sources.

The Dove and Tick Creek Project's success in attracting grants is largely due to its multiple benefits. The project is located at the southern end of Dove Canyon Golf Course and is designed to capture irrigation runoff and pump it up to Dove Lake. This not only helps downstream habitat by keeping creeks dry during the dry seasons but also increases TCWD's non-drinking water supply used for irrigation, conserving drinking water and making TCWD more drought resilient. The project is scheduled for design in 2025 and construction in 2026.
